This letter is in response to your request to amend Nassau County's Child and Family Services 2021 Child Care Plan. Nassau County has proposed to amend the following:

Proposed changes:

Appendix L section 7a; 7b; comment sections would read as follows; "For a period not to exceed 24 consecutive calendar months when an applicant lacks the basic skills necessary to obtain at least entry-level employment.

Appendix L sections 7f; and 7h comment sections would add "For a period not to exceed 24 consecutive calendar months when an applicant lacks the basic skill necessary to obtain at least entry level employment."

Appendix L sections 8, 9, and 10 option should be changed to "yes". The comment section should read as follows - "For a period not to exceed 24 consecutive calendar months when an applicant lacks the basic skills necessary to obtain at least entry-level employment."

Appendix M #1

The Family Share percentage selected for Nassau County will be reduced to 3%.

Appendix R section 4

The number of absences allowed per child will be the allowable 24 absences with an additional 16 absences. The total number of allowed absences for Nassau County will be 40 absences.
