Dear Commissioner Pierre:

Thank you for keeping the Office of Children and Family Services (OCFS) updated on the challenges Suffolk County continues to experience as a result of the cyber intrusion that shut down the County network. It is our understanding that recovery of the network to the fullest extent will take some time, and this impacts the district's ability to process applications and payments for child care assistance.

OCFS is committed to working with Suffolk County to evaluate the need for waivers and approves the extension of the following waivers until December 31, 2022.

- Waiver: 18 NYCRR 415.4(a)(2) and (3) Time period for determination of eligibility. At a minimum, the district will manually make eligibility determinations as timely as possible not to exceed 60 days.
- Waiver: 18 NYCRR 415.4(a)(3) Required documentation for determination of eligibility. At a minimum, the district must verify the child's age, citizenship status, financial eligibility, and programmatic eligibility when making determinations.
- Waiver: 18 NYCRR 415.4(a)(4) Written notice of eligibility determinations. At a minimum, the district will verbally notify the provider and the parent via phone communication until such time as the notice can be provided in writing.

Thank you for your commitment to the children and families of Suffolk County. I look forward to working with you as you continue to emerge from this unfortunate crisis.
