This report, prepared pursuant to section 20(5) of the Social Services Law (SSL), concerns:

- A report made to the New York Statewide Central Register of Child Abuse and Maltreatment (SCR) involving the death of a child.
- The death of a child for whom child protective services has an open case.
- The death of a child whose care and custody or custody and guardianship has been transferred to an authorized agency.
- The death of a child for whom the local department of social services has an open preventive service case.

The Office of Children and Family Services (OCFS) is mandated by section 20 of the SSL to investigate or cause for the investigation of the cause and circumstances surrounding the death, review such investigation, and prepare and issue a fatality report in regard to the categories of deaths noted above involving a child, except where a local or regional fatality review team issues a report, as authorized by law.

Such report must include: the cause of death; the identification of child protective or other services provided or actions taken regard to such child and child’s family; any extraordinary or pertinent information concerning the circumstances of the child’s death; whether the child or the child’s family received assistance, care or services from the social services district prior to the child’s death; any action or further investigation undertaken by OCFS or the social services district since the child’s death; and as appropriate, recommendations for local or state administrative or policy changes.

This report contains no information that would identify the deceased child, his or her siblings, the parent, parents, or other persons legally responsible for the child, and any members of the deceased child’s household.

By statute, this report will be forwarded to the social services district, chief county executive officer, chairperson of the local legislative body of the county where the child died and the social services district that had legal custody of the child, if different. Notice of the issuance of this report will be sent to the Speaker of the Assembly and the Temporary President of the Senate of the State of New York.

This report may **only** be disclosed to the public by OCFS pursuant to section 20(5) of the SSL. **It may be released by OCFS only after OCFS has determined that such disclosure is not contrary to the best interests of the deceased child’s siblings or other children in the household.**

OCFS’ review included an examination of actions taken by individual caseworkers and supervisors within the social services district and agencies under contract with the social services district. The observations and recommendations contained in this report reflect OCFS’ assessment and the performance of these agencies.

Presenting Information

On Monday 11/30/15, the 3 month old child was found deceased in a crib. The last time the child was seen alive was at 11pm on 11/29/15. Family friends, a man and woman were providing child care for the deceased child and her 2 year old sibling since 11/28/15. The family friends have regular and consistent contact with these children making them persons legally responsible. This was an otherwise healthy child therefore all adults in the home are considered alleged subjects pending the outcome of the investigation. The roles of the mother and father of the deceased child and 2 yr. old sibling are unknown. The roles of the children of the family friends, 12 yr. old, 11 yr. old, 9 yr. old, 7 yr. old, 6 yr. old, 3 yr. old and 3 yr. old are unknown.

Executive Summary

This case involves the death of a child in Rensselaer County. On 11/30/15, RCDSS received an SCR report with the allegations of DOA/Fatality against the man and woman who were providing child care for the 3 month old subject child at the time of her death and her 1 year old sister. The investigation began immediately with interviews taking place at the CAC and in collaboration with local LE. LDSS interviewed all children of appropriate age and observed them for safety. The 1 yr old surviving sibling was observed for safety. LDSS addressed discrepancies in the time line of events. At the time of submission of this report, the final autopsy was not available. However, the Medical Examiner reported preliminary findings indicated no signs of trauma, abuse or suspicion. LDSS followed up with both families throughout the investigation to encourage participation in mental health treatment and bereavement services.

LDSS faced several challenges in the investigation of this case. The LE investigator involved retired in December 2015, one month after the fatality. The criminal case was essentially closed at that time and there was a delay in obtaining the police statements and scene photos. The City Fire Department required LDSS to go through the City legal department which caused delays in access to first responders. LDSS made diligent efforts to contact the first responders who worked the midnight shift and were involved on the day of the fatality. Finally, the ADA was able to assist and the interviews took place. These delays resulted in an untimely 30 day safety assessment. At the time of this report, RCDSS had not yet made a determination regarding the allegations.

LDSS Response

Upon receipt of the SCR report LDSS immediately began a joint investigation with LE. The family caring for the SC at the time of the fatality was brought to the CAC, which included a man, woman, and 5 out of their 7 children. This family had an open long term CPS case at the time of the fatality. Their order of supervision had expired in October but the case was not officially closed yet. CPS CWs interviewed all the children and the man and woman separately. The man and woman had been providing child care for the SC and her 1 year old sibling since 11/25/16. Beginning in November, the man and woman had been providing child care approx. 3 nights per week when the mother worked.

The interviews revealed that all the children as well as the caretakers had a similar timeline of events starting the evening of 11/29/15. The family watched TV together from 9 to 10pm. The woman then brought the SC upstairs. Around 10:30pm, she fed the subject child a bottle and then placed her in her bouncy seat, which was routine. Once she fell asleep, about an hour later, the woman placed the SC in her crib, located in another bedroom on the same floor. The SC woke around 12am, and was fed 2oz in a bottle by the woman, and then fed another 2 oz. around 12:45am. Between 6:30am and 6:45am, the woman went to get the SC out of the crib and she was not moving. She placed her hand on the SC's back to see if she was breathing. The child was purple, stiff, and not moving. The woman called for the man to come help her. The man put the SC on the kitchen table downstairs and started CPR and the meantime the woman was called 911. The man initially said that he thought there was a feeding around 3am. In a follow up interview, the man acknowledged that it was the woman who did the feedings and he must have had the time wrong. All the caretakers' children were interviewed and their timeline of events from the night before and the morning of the fatality were consistent with the parents. The RCDSS CW went to the caretakers' home and no safety concerns were identified.

On 11/30/15, the mother of the SC was interviewed. She reported she had been staying off and on with the caretakers since Thanksgiving. She left the SC and her 1 yr. old child there on 11/28/15 around 5pm. She denied any concerns regarding the family caring for her children. She provided a typical sleep/eating schedule: she usually went to bed for the night around 11pm and woke once around 2 or 3am for a feeding. The 1yr old surviving sibling was assessed for safety. She denied the SC had any medical problems or health concerns. The bio father of the SC was interviewed at the jail where he had been incarcerated prior to the fatality. He provided no information around the fatality.

The CW did not find discrepancies between their interviews and the ones given to LE. The crib where the child was found revealed there one fleece blanket that was used. The home was cluttered and cigarette butts were observed throughout the home, however, there were no safety hazards. Preliminary autopsy findings revealed no signs of trauma or suspicion. Medical documentation showed the subject child was healthy with no concerns noted. There were no concerns reported by first responders. The case notes indicated a history of the SC sleeping on her stomach despite the mother learning about safe sleep from the pediatrician and her Healthy Families worker.

 The 10 yr. old had a burn on his finger, the 18 mos old had a bruise on her head on 2 occasions, and the 4 yr. old looked to be very ill with a cold. All children were behind on doctor visits. There was very little food in the house on multiple occasions despite providing information on food pantries and WIC. The parents used ratchet straps on the outside of several bedroom doors to keep the children in the rooms. The 10yr. old had springs coming through his mattress. The 12 yr. old girl was not engaged in MH treatment and her prescription was not filled. All allegations were indicated except L/B/W. All parties said the bruise on the 7 yr. old was from a toy being thrown at him by a sibling.

OCFS Review Results:
 LDSS conducted a thorough investigation and interviewed all the children. The 10 yr. old had a burn from a hair straightener that the mother left on. The mother stated that the 18 month old had just started walking and walked into a wall which is the cause of the 2 different bruises on her head. Throughout the case, home visits were conducted and the parents struggled to maintain food in the home despite being given resources. The 11yr. old stated that if they run out of food, they wait until the next day to eat. The 11yr old went to a crisis children's shelter early in the investigation due to her behavior. Recommendations were made for her MH upon discharge, which the parents did not do.

 The 7yr. old child was interviewed at school and stated his father hit him with a hammer. A green bruise was observed on his forehead above the right eye and appeared to be healing . The child disclosed that he and his brother were fighting and his father broke the door in half and hit him in the head with a hammer. The man and woman denied the allegations. The man recalled a night when the 7 yr. old and his brother were awake in the middle of the night and he yelled at them and took the TV from their room. LE did not observe any broken doors or ones that had been replaced. All other children denied their father hitting 7 yr. old. There was no credible evidence, all allegations unfounded.



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OCFS Review Results:

The review revealed that the bruise may have been sustained by the two brothers playing rough with each other. The 7yr. old changed his story regarding the bruise several times throughout the investigation. The mother acknowledged that the 7 and 9 yr. old boys wrestle with each other and she agreed to limit the amount of play time the two brothers have unsupervised in their room.

Known CPS History Outside of NYS

The family of the deceased child lived in South Carolina in 2011-2012. A child abuse report was received by the South Carolina Department of Social Services on 3/14/11 with the allegation of Threat of Harm Physical Abuse based on the allegation that the father hit the then 6 yr old child with a belt causing bruising to the face and back. On 4/25/11, the allegations were indicated based on observing faint bruising on the child and the child disclosing his father hit him with the belt. The case determination summary references a similar report of Threat of Harm Physical Abuse against the father regarding the same child in October of 2010 that was unfounded. South Carolina DSS continued involvement and recommended the 8 yr old sibling receive counseling regarding past trauma, that a safety plan remain in place that the father not be left alone unsupervised with any of the children, and that the father participate in anger management classes.
