This report, prepared pursuant to section 20(5) of the Social Services Law (SSL), concerns:

- A report made to the New York Statewide Central Register of Child Abuse and Maltreatment (SCR) involving the death of a child.
- The death of a child for whom child protective services has an open case.
- The death of a child whose care and custody or custody and guardianship has been transferred to an authorized agency.
- The death of a child for whom the local department of social services has an open preventive service case.

The Office of Children and Family Services (OCFS) is mandated by section 20 of the SSL to investigate or cause for the investigation of the cause and circumstances surrounding the death, review such investigation, and prepare and issue a fatality report in regard to the categories of deaths noted above involving a child, except where a local or regional fatality review team issues a report, as authorized by law.

Such report must include: the cause of death; the identification of child protective or other services provided or actions taken regard to such child and child’s family; any extraordinary or pertinent information concerning the circumstances of the child’s death; whether the child or the child’s family received assistance, care or services from the social services district prior to the child’s death; any action or further investigation undertaken by OCFS or the social services district since the child’s death; and as appropriate, recommendations for local or state administrative or policy changes.

This report contains no information that would identify the deceased child, his or her siblings, the parent, parents, or other persons legally responsible for the child, and any members of the deceased child’s household.

By statute, this report will be forwarded to the social services district, chief county executive officer, chairperson of the local legislative body of the county where the child died and the social services district that had legal custody of the child, if different. Notice of the issuance of this report will be sent to the Speaker of the Assembly and the Temporary President of the Senate of the State of New York.

This report may **only** be disclosed to the public by OCFS pursuant to section 20(5) of the SSL. **It may be released by OCFS only after OCFS has determined that such disclosure is not contrary to the best interests of the deceased child’s siblings or other children in the household.**

OCFS’ review included an examination of actions taken by individual caseworkers and supervisors within the social services district and agencies under contract with the social services district. The observations and recommendations contained in this report reflect OCFS’ assessment and the performance of these agencies.

Presenting Information

An SCR report alleged that on 4/6/18, the father was alone in his bedroom with his 14yo autistic son. The father was getting high on Oxycodone and intoxicated on alcohol. The father passed out in the presence of the child as a result of his drug and alcohol use. The child was then able to access the Oxycodone and ingest it. The child suffered a drug overdose. At 3:30PM on 4/6/18, the grandmother found the child unresponsive in the father's bedroom with the father asleep. The grandmother was aware the child needed a higher level of supervision due to suffering from autism; however, she did not check on the child for at least an hour. The child was transported to the hospital and pronounced dead. The roles of the 5 other children in the home (ages 14, 14, 11, 9, & 7) were unknown. The child's mother was incarcerated and had no role.

Executive Summary

On 4/7/18, an SCR report was made regarding concerns of a fatality, lack of supervision, inadequate guardianship, and parent's drug/alcohol misuse. This fatality report concerns the death of the 14yo SC that occurred on 4/6/18, as a result of an accidental ingestion of his father's prescription opiates. There were 2 minor surviving siblings and 3 cousins (ages 14, 11, 11, 9, and 8) living in the home. The 14yo cousin was the only other child in the home at the time of the death.

Schenectady County Department of Social Services (SCDSS) coordinated efforts with LE upon being notified of the child's death. An autopsy was performed and the ME ruled the child's death an accidental overdose. The DA was notified of the child's death.

On 4/6/18, the paternal grandmother (PGM), SC, SC's BF, and a 14yo cousin were the only ones in the home while the paternal uncle's girlfriend took the other children out to eat. BF was sleeping on a futon in the family room and SC was nearby watching TV and playing with toys. The PGM saw SC watching TV around 4:30PM and then saw him napping around 5PM. While PGM was cleaning, she noticed pills on the floor next to SC's toys. BF had been taking Oxycodone from a surgery he had just had. PGM found more pills in a plastic bag that looked like the corner had been chewed off. SC was known to put things in his mouth, so PGM checked on him and discovered he was not breathing. The PU lived downstairs and heard PGM yell for help. PU and SC's 19yo sibling ran upstairs to help and called 911. PU performed CPR on SC until EMS arrived. SC was transported to the hospital and could not be resuscitated.

SCDSS gathered information about the child's death from the PGM, PU, the 19yo sibling, the 14yo cousin, EMS, LE, hospital staff, and the ME.

Several visits were made to see the family and collaterals were interviewed. Bereavement counseling and funeral assistance was offered to the family. The child's mother was in prison and was interviewed by Orleans County Department of Social Services. The mother had not seen the child since 2015. The family had extensive CPS history. A safety plan was put in place for the children to be cared for by the PU and to have no contact with the father or PGM. BF was arrested and charged with felony endangering the welfare of a child. SCDSS completed required reports and safety assessments accurately and on time and completed a thorough investigation. The case was indicated on 6/4/18 and opened for services.

LDSS Response

SCDSS learned that SC died on 4/6/18. On this same date, SCDSS initiated their investigation and coordinated efforts with LE. The CW spoke to the source of the report, notified the DA and ME of the death, and completed a CPS history check. At the time of SC's death, there were 2 minor SS and 3 cousins (ages 14, 11, 11, 9, and 8) living in the home.

On 4/6/18, CW visited the hotel where the family had gone after SC's death since their home was considered a crime scene. CW spoke with PU's girlfriend (OA2) who had taken all the CHN out to eat that day except SC and the 14yo cousin. Present in the home that day were SC, PGM, the 14yo cousin, and SC's BF. OA2 said BF was not supposed to be in the home but the kids may have let him in. CW observed the SS and surviving cousins who lived in the home. CW made a safety plan with OA2 and PGM that PGM was not to be alone with the CHN at any time and PGM agreed.

CW interviewed PGM who gave a statement to LE which said the SC was in her care and custody. She said BF was temporarily staying with her because he just had surgery. PGM said the morning of 4/6/18, BF was sleeping and SC was



playing with toys and watching TV around 8:30AM; PGM was doing house work. PGM said she again saw SC watching TV around 4:30PM and then saw him napping around 5PM. PGM said during the day, SC would get tired and put himself down for a nap. PGM said she went to the room where SC and BF were sleeping to clean and noticed pills on the floor next to SC's toys. PGM said she picked up the pills and put them in a bag; she knew BF was taking Oxycodone from his surgery and that was what the pills were. PGM then found more pills in a plastic bag that looked like the corner had been chewed off. PGM said SC was known to put things in his mouth, so she checked on SC and discovered he was not breathing. PGM pulled SC onto the floor and yelled for PA and SC's 19yo sibling, who called 911. PGM was sure the pills were BF's and they would have been in his pants pockets; his pants were on the floor near where he was sleeping.

PU confirmed he ran upstairs to help when he heard PGM yell. PU said he started CPR and brownish bile came out of SC's mouth. PU said SC had autism but no medical issues. PU described the bag with the pills that looked like the corner had been chewed off and said they were BF's. SC's 19yo sibling confirmed these events and said this was BF's fault because those were his pills. CW let PU know BF was not allowed in the home or to care for the CHN. PU said SC's BM was in prison.

LE spoke with BF upon arrival to the home and BF appeared lethargic. He said he had been sleeping on the futon in the room where SC was found. BF said he recently had surgery and was taking Oxycodone. BF pulled 2 Ziploc bags out of his pockets; 1 was empty with the corner ripped off. LE observed several small yellow pills on the floor where SC was.

CW interviewed all first responders who gave the same account and said a male was performing CPR on SC upon arrival and there was vomit next to SC's head. SC was transported to the hospital and could not be resuscitated. A Dr. at the hospital said SC could have been dead for over an hour.

All SS and other CHN living in the home were interviewed and confirmed SC would often put objects in his mouth.

CW interviewed PGM's husband who no longer resided in the home but continued to help care for SC. He said SC was very active and put everything in his mouth. CW obtained school records, and SC's school noted he frequently attempted to mouth inappropriate objects.

Orleans County Department of Social Services interviewed BM in jail, who said she had not seen SC since 2015. CW offered the family assistance with bereavement counseling and funeral costs. BF claimed that on 4/6/18 SC somehow got into his pills while he was sleeping and it was an accident. BF was arrested and charged with felony endangering the welfare of a child. The case was indicated on 6/4/18 and opened for services.

CPS - Investigative History More Than Three Years Prior to the Fatality

From 2000-2014, SF had a total of 11 indicated cases and 18 unfounded cases. The cases involved allegations of IG, EdN, LS, LMC, XCP, CD/A, and L/B/W. These reports involved the SC, the SS, and SF's former stepchildren.

From 2009-2013, the PGM had 1 indicated case and 4 unfounded cases. The allegations in these cases were IG and OTH/COI regarding the SC and the 19yo SS.

Known CPS History Outside of NYS

There is no known CPS history outside of NYS.

Preventive Services History

On 5/13/16, an FSS was opened due to CHN not attending school regularly and it negatively effecting academics. There were also concerns the CHN had a medical issue that was not being treated appropriately. Further, SF and his girlfriend had a history of drug use. This services case was court ordered and monitored by CPS. Families Work program from Northeast Parent & Child Society was the prevention program assigned. From case start to December 2016, the family only met with the worker four times. Families Work closed their case due to non-participation on 12/17/16. CPS filed a violation in Family Court and a hearing took place on 12/9/16. At that time, BM and SF were reported to have been under the influence; BM left the courthouse before being called. A drug test was ordered for SF, but he refused. As a result, the CHN were removed and court was adjourned until 12/15/16. All 4 CHN were placed with PGM (1017). BF's 2 CHN were later transferred to the placement of their PU. The girlfriend's CHN were placed with their BF. BF and his girlfriend did not complete any of their service plan goals. The services case was closed after custody of the CHN was established in court.
