This report, prepared pursuant to section 20(5) of the Social Services Law (SSL), concerns:

- A report made to the New York Statewide Central Register of Child Abuse and Maltreatment (SCR) involving the death of a child.
- The death of a child for whom child protective services has an open case.
- The death of a child whose care and custody or custody and guardianship has been transferred to an authorized agency.
- The death of a child for whom the local department of social services has an open preventive service case.

The Office of Children and Family Services (OCFS) is mandated by section 20 of the SSL to investigate or cause for the investigation of the cause and circumstances surrounding the death, review such investigation, and prepare and issue a fatality report in regard to the categories of deaths noted above involving a child, except where a local or regional fatality review team issues a report, as authorized by law.

Such report must include: the cause of death; the identification of child protective or other services provided or actions taken regard to such child and child’s family; any extraordinary or pertinent information concerning the circumstances of the child’s death; whether the child or the child’s family received assistance, care or services from the social services district prior to the child’s death; any action or further investigation undertaken by OCFS or the social services district since the child’s death; and as appropriate, recommendations for local or state administrative or policy changes.

This report contains no information that would identify the deceased child, his or her siblings, the parent, parents, or other persons legally responsible for the child, and any members of the deceased child’s household.

By statute, this report will be forwarded to the social services district, chief county executive officer, chairperson of the local legislative body of the county where the child died and the social services district that had legal custody of the child, if different. Notice of the issuance of this report will be sent to the Speaker of the Assembly and the Temporary President of the Senate of the State of New York.

This report may **only** be disclosed to the public by OCFS pursuant to section 20(5) of the SSL. **It may be released by OCFS only after OCFS has determined that such disclosure is not contrary to the best interests of the deceased child’s siblings or other children in the household.**

OCFS’ review included an examination of actions taken by individual caseworkers and supervisors within the social services district and agencies under contract with the social services district. The observations and recommendations contained in this report reflect OCFS’ assessment and the performance of these agencies.

Presenting Information

The 5/26/20 report alleged the mother strapped her two thirteen-year-old daughters with belts, by their arms and chest, to dining room chairs as a form of discipline for not listening. The chairs were wired for the purpose of electrocution. She then electrocuted the children leading to their death. The mother hit them on their buttocks with belts causing welts. The mother had a history of not being able to “handle” her daughters. There was a neighbor present for the electrocution and who tried to intervene, but the mother kicked the neighbor who called 911. It was reported that the mother was pregnant. A male arrived at the home and put the mother in handcuffs and placed her in a police car. EMS did not arrive until 40 minutes later to transport the children to the hospital or morgue.

Executive Summary

The SCR registered a report of child abuse and maltreatment against a mother on behalf of her two thirteen-year-old female children; the allegations were DOA/Fatality, IG, XCP and L/B/W. The ACS investigation showed the family did not reside at the case address or exist. There was no school record of the children. ACS interviewed LE and found the family was not known to the reported precinct. ACS conducted several database clearances that yielded no results of the reported family. ACS unsubstantiated the allegations and closed the case stating they found no credible evidence.

According to ACS, the report narrative contained conflicting information that stated the children were being electrocuted upon arrival and a neighbor turned off the electric chairs and the children were dead upon arrival. Conflicting dates of birth for the mother were given and only the month and day for the children’s date of birth was provided. The narrative contained two phone numbers for a precinct in addition to a cell phone number and an email address that connected to no one familiar to the reported family. ACS’ supervisory and casework team found this case was called in maliciously.

LDSS Response

ACS initiated the 5/26/20 investigation within the required timeframe. The ACS Specialist contacted the phone number reported in the narrative and it led to an organization which was closed. The Specialist called another reported number and it was out of service.

The ACS Specialist contacted the precinct and was told no fatal incidents were reported during the month of May; and the case address was not in their catchment district. There was no officer by the name given or by the email address reported. The Specialist also contacted the precinct assigned to the case address and was told the same.

On 5/26/20, ACS conducted a search for the reported family that yielded no results. The reported phone numbers belonged to persons who resided out of New York State and were not familiar with the family. The Specialist visited the case address and the reported family name was not listed on the directory or the mailbox. The Specialist interviewed the tenant and her adult son; they reported no teens resided in the home. Three neighbors reported no teens resided in the building. The building personnel, who resided in the building, reported the same and added that the building currently housed only very young children.

On 5/27/20, the Specialist proceeded to an address similar to the reported address and several tenants located on the fifth and sixth floors reported no children by the name on the report resided in the building and not for the past 20 years.

ACS' investigative consultants researched the official database systems and found no evidence to suggest the alleged



subject and children existed. ACS investigation involved the District Attorney’s Office and LE, and yielded no evidence that the reported incident occurred. ACS concluded the reported concerns had been maliciously and falsely reported. This investigation resulted in no evidence of a fatality.

On 7/2/20, ACS unsubstantiated the allegations of DOA/Fatality, L/B/W, XCP and IG of the two thirteen-year-old children by the mother citing lack of credible evidence to support the allegations. ACS closed the case.
